From July 2024, TPMS/TPRS will be mandatory for all newly registered vehicles/trailers.






## What does this mean for you as a fleet operator?

In future, your new vehicles will be equipped with Tyre Pressure Monitoring System (TPMS) ex works. In conjunction with our cargofleet 3 telematics portal, you can use this to achieve sustainable savings with various functions.

### **TMPS Information**

Tyre pressure, tyre temperature, evaluations, alarms

- TPMS fleet report (e.g. to be called up in the morning)

- · Integration of TPMS information into digital maintenance calendar
- · Alarms in case of deviations (via email and SMS)
